Zack Elliott is a contemporary folk singer-songwriter based out of Bolton, Ontario. Through powerful imagery and melodies laced with melancholy, Zack writes music with the hopes he can comfort his listeners and make them feel less isolated in their life experience. He independently released his debut EP "Caught Half Alive" in March 2021.

## Long Bio

Zack Elliott is a modern folk singer-songwriter based in Bolton, Ontario. Greatly influenced by the works of *Gregory Alan Isakov* and *The Tallest Man on Earth*, Zack creates music laced with melancholy and poetic writing in the vein of *City and Colour*, *Leonard Cohen*, and *Iron & Wine*. Zack's goal is to comfort his listeners and make them feel less isolated in their life experience with his music.

After graduating with a biology degree, he took on the pursuit of music and recorded, produced, and independently released his debut EP "Caught Half Alive" in March 2021. A year later the project has been streamed over 7,400 times with 'Honeysuckle' and 'In Limbo' being highlight tracks. Zack's striking imagery and the soothing, dream-like atmosphere of his work evoke the emotions he conveys in his listeners.

Zack continues to write and record solo, and with his folk trio 'The Vanishing Pheasants' with whom he is booking a tour. He is also furthering his artistic development with the Canadian Musicians Co-operative, with whom he regularly performs around the Greater Toronto Area, while also performing independently across southern Ontario.
